INTRODUCTION

Taking this process into account, it should be emphasized that, in the current period of strategic development based on national progress, there arises a need to enhance the social and other forms of activity of young people and to analyze its significance in the period of ongoing global changes.

On this basis, the issues of improving the social activity of young people are considered one of the most important issues of the present time. Today, in New Uzbekistan, at a time when reforms have entered a new stage, the formation among young people of such important qualities as patriotism, responsibility, tolerance, legal culture, and innovative thinking is an important issue.

In his Address to the Oliy Majlis, President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. Mirziyoyev, regarding the need to enhance the activity of young people in social life, ensure their civic responsibility, innovative initiative, and spiritual and moral maturity in the practice of comprehensive reforms in today's modern society, states the following: "In general, in the development of any society, the healthy and well-rounded upbringing of the younger generation, which ensures its future, plays a decisive role. Therefore, in further increasing the scale and effectiveness of our reforms, we rely on our comprehensively developed, energetic and enterprising young people who have thoroughly mastered modern knowledge and professions."

In modern conditions, enhancing the social activity of young people in the comprehensive development of society and turning them into full participants in social processes is an issue of urgent importance. In the process of ensuring the comprehensive and rapid development of society, modernizing the country, and liberalizing all spheres of life, the innovative initiatives of young people, their transformation into full participants in social processes, and their contribution to the manifestation of principles related to development serve as an important factor.



The important activity carried out by young people in social life is an integral part of the important traditions and values related to development in society. In the social practice of society, activity is characterized by young people's awareness of their duty and responsibility before society and by the realization of a sense of respect for the law. Article 29 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights states: "Everyone has duties to the community in which alone the free and full development of his personality is possible. In the exercise of his rights and freedoms, everyone shall be subject only to such limitations as are determined by law solely for the purpose of securing due recognition and respect for the rights and freedoms of others and of meeting the just requirements of morality, public order and the general welfare in a democratic society," which expresses the manifestation of the principle of tolerance that should be inherent in every person.

These factors demonstrate that the measures carried out in the process of developing the social activity and spiritual culture of young people should lead to significant progress. High results in the deep integration of young people into social processes contribute to the improvement of relevant views on the concept of society and human development as a developing factor. This improvement is characterized by its social nature and its scientific and creative foundation. In this sense, according to scholars, "The activation of the human factor, which contributes to increasing labor productivity, improving its quality and promoting human creative initiative, is connected with the correct and scientifically grounded formulation of these socio-economic and spiritual tasks."

Taking precisely these factors into account, conducting activities aimed at increasing the social activity of young people increases the significance of their contribution to the process of social development. Such a reality:

Improving the social views of young people contributes to the realization of other goals valuable to them through a healthy and constructive, enjoyable life in the development of society and ensures the expansion of young people's opportunities. At the same time, it means ensuring justice and sustainable development in society and the active participation of young people in this process. Young people, both individually and on a group basis, are simultaneously stakeholder groups and driving forces of social development. Improvement in the indicators of young people's social activity contributes to the stabilization of spiritual life in society, environmental protection, equality of opportunities, expansion of personal freedoms, social justice, and an increase in the level of cultural life.

According to A. Saitkasimov, "The participation of citizens in political processes, the analysis of their socio-political activity from the perspective of the present day, and drawing appropriate conclusions regarding its distinctive place in the political processes of society and its fulfillment of one of the main tasks in preserving a stable environment in the country are matters of great

Also, undoubtedly, replacing destructive views in the minds of young people with constructive ideas is one of the main criteria for ensuring socio-spiritual stability in society.
